SCRIP cutoff for 2010-11 tuition credit

The last day to purchase SCRIP and have your 2010-11 tuition credited will be TODAY, Friday, May 28. Any SCRIP purchased after May 28 will go toward your 2011-12 tuition. Many of you have saved several hundreds of dollars using this program. Keep it up, and encourage others to join in the tuition savings!

2010-11 Tuition PAID-IN-FULL DATES

Anyone who pays their entire family tuition account in full for the 2010-11 school year by the end of the day on Tuesday, June 1, will receive a reduction of \$35 for Preschool tuition and \$150 for K-8 tuition per family.

Anyone who has utilized SCRIP in the past year and has a credit to apply to their tuition will have until the end of the day on Tuesday, June 15 to make their family tuition payment in full.

Sign up is open Monday, May 24, and ends Friday, July 9. Registration forms are available at the church office.

On camp day, youth will be registered at the beginning of the camp, so be sure to show up early. For all camps, you'll find the camp registration table in the Trinity gym.
